#### From the Interim Pastor's Desk—



Greetings! I'm your interim pastor. Let me introduce myself. I am an ordained minister of Word and Sacrament in the ELCA. And I am a trained intentional interim pastor. Before coming to Spirit of Grace, I served fifteen interims in four different states. Several of those interims involved more than one congregation, so I have served thirty-one different congregations, not counting all the places where I have done Sunday morning pulpit supply for pastors on vacation. I don't even want to hazard a guess about how many different people I have served in those different congregations. Please be patient with me as I learn your names and don't be surprised if I call you by someone else's name!

Transition times are times of opportunity. My role as your interim pastor includes helping you to make the best possible use of the opportunities that God is giving you. Working with your Board, other leaders, and every person in the congregation, I will seek to equip you to move through this transition in a way that will help you discern where God is leading you. As the weeks unfold, you will be hearing much more about this. In addition to helping you make good use of the interim time, I will be your pastor.

As your pastor, I will preach and lead worship. I will baptize and provide memorial services. I will walk with those who experience crises and pray for all members. I will be your pastor. Of course, all of this is more complicated than it was just six months ago; as we live in this time of pandemic, some things will have to be sorted out as we go. My position is two-thirds time. This means that I will work an average of twenty-seven to thirty-three hours a week. Sometimes I will work long days, other days I will work a few hours. Friday will be my "Sabbath" day when I will do no work unless there is an emergency.

A pastor's role requires flexibility. Although my position is part-time, the role of a pastor is full-time. I will be available for emergencies twenty-four hours a day, seven days a week unless I am out of town for vacation or continuing education. Usually, each week I post a schedule on my office door that lets people know what I plan to be doing when; but I will have to figure out an alternative under our current circumstances. If anyone was a member of Our Redeemer Lutheran Church in the 1980's, you might remember my brother: Pastor Stephen Seiffert. You were his first call after he graduated from seminary in 1982. My two nephews were born in Hood River, in 1985 and 1987. Steve lives in St. Anthony, Minnesota. (His wife, Rachel, died in 2012.) By coincidence, June 30<sup>th</sup> is the date of his retirement from ministry; as he finishes his ministry, I begin my ministry in the place where he began his!

It is a pleasure to be here as your interim pastor. I am confident that God will bless our time together.
